Water Smart Home Audit

Install a water efficient shower head and take shorter showers

Install a dual flush toilet – this can save up to 35,000 litres of water p/year

Don't leave taps running while brushing teeth, washing vegies or waiting for the water to cool in summer.

Save Water in the garden – use mulch, select species that will thrive in your area, water roots not the leaves, water less often but more thoroughly, use a trigger hose and install a rain water tank.

If you have a swimming pool use a cover – this will reduce evaporation by 80%
